Otto Addo have won the Bundesliga with Borussia Dortmund and played in the UEFA Cup Final.

The experience that Otto brings, not only as a player but also as coach at Hamburg, means that we will add a person to the coaching team that will give us important knowledge that we can use in the training every day to make the players even better, says Kasper Hjulmand.

The new assistant coach started his career as coach at Hamburger SV, where he mainly worked with the U/19, but also helped with reserves and first team.

- I'm really thrilled for this new opportunity and I'm looking forward to meeting the other coaches and players. I'm really excited with the big Danish talent here that can be supplemented by players from Right to Dream, this will give us an unique chance of developing people to the highest level, says Addo.
