

Emre Mor sold to Dortmund

It has already been a fantastic journey for 18-year-old Emre Mor, who back in November played his debut match for FC Nordsjælland in the Danish Superliga.

Now he is at the European Championship finals with the Turkish A-team, and after the summer break Emre Mor will swap the red FCN jersey with Borussia Dortmund's yellow and black jersey.

Sporting Director Carsten V. Jensen explains: - I wish to congratulate Emre with this transfer, and it is also something that everyone in and around FC Nordsjælland can be proud of. Everyone has put in a superb effort to support Emre and once again our club culture has proved to be really strong.
