

Divine Naah to FC Nordsjælland

The 20-year-old Ghanaian midfielder Divine Naah comes on loan to FC Nordsjælland. Divine has received his education at the Right to Dream Academy in Ghana, but joined Manchester City at the age of eighteen.

Sporting director Carsten V. Jensen explains:

- We are getting a young player who has a desire to control the game, but also a player who is involved in both the offensive and defensive part of the game. He operates in the midfield but has offensive qualities that we hope to develop here in FCN. Now we need to bring Divine in the a good physical form before we let him compete for a spot in the first team, says CV.

Divine Naah began at the academy in Ghana in 2007, where he received his school and footballing education until he was 18 years old when left the Right to Dream in favor of a professional contract at Manchester City.

- I am grateful for this opportunity and I look forward to getting fully fit and helping the team to get good results in the league. It is an exciting club, and I hope that with my change I can lead the way for many other young players, says Divine Naah.

Divine Naah has most recently appeared for NAC Breda, where he has played 34 matches and scored two goals.
