

FCN hires Spanish goalkeeper coach

Iñaki Caña Pavon is the new goalkeeping coach for FC Nordsjælland. The Spaniard possesses the highest goalkeeping coach education in Spain and the UEFA A license for goalkeeper coaches. Pavon comes with experience from FC Barcelona's academy, C.E. Sabadel and has run his own goalkeeper trainer academy in Barcelona.

Sporting director Carsten V. Jensen:

- We have chosen to innovate in terms of developing the goalkeeper skills, which in modern football are growing in importance. Inaki comes with experience from Spanish football, and with his background within the highly respected Spanish goalkeeper coach education, we believe FCN and Inaki we will make a good match.

- Inaki visited us in December to train a number of our academy goalkeepers, and we saw then, a new way to train goalkeepers. It will be very interesting to see him develop the goalkeeper training here at FCN.

41-year-old Pavon will have the daily responsibility for the training of FCN's goalkeepers in the Superliga squad, and he will also help to plan the training for the academies in Farum and Ghana.
